



Rob the M.A.C. Biographical Sketch

“Classy!” “Beautiful!” “A journey for the spirit and soul” This is what listeners are saying about the music of Rob the MAC. Rob the MAC is the premier artist of an up and coming genre called *instrumental inspiration*.

He has been asked to play at numerous churches, banquets, weddings, concerts and other functions in various cities across the country – including Chicago, Meridian, Mobile, Montgomery, Pensacola and Spring City. He has played for crowds in excess of 400 people. Rob has recorded on over seven albums and has distributed over 2,000 CDs. Through his website, people have experienced his music in multiple geographic regions. His CDs have been distributed in the US from Maine to California, as well as outside countries including Canada and Jamaica.

In February 2009, Rob’s track titled “Chilled Out...” debuted on WVAS 90.7 FM (<http://www.wvasfm.org>). The track has been played weekly ever since its debut.

Rob’s influences includes musicians from a variety of styles and genres – from the ballads of Ben Tankard, Allen & Allen, Dino, and Thelonious Monk to the eccentric diversity of Kirk Franklin, Tonex, Carmen, and Prince.
